Covid update

Updated CofE guidance requires the wearing of masks during services unless exempt from doing so. The choir may remove face-coverings to sing, but congregations are encouraged to leave their masks on. Please don't try to wear a mask in church if you suffer from a chest or heart condition - we don't want you passing out! The rest of us will wear masks to protect you. We will continue with the hand sanitizing and ventilation so please put on an extra layer - the ventilation is for your own good!
