Services of Remembrance

Please be aware that today, **Sunday 9th November** our service of Holy Communion and Explorers at St Mark's will commence at **10am**, and will include an act of Remembrance at **11am**.

Then, this afternoon a Remembrance Service will be held at St Edmund's War Memorial at 3pm.

Chaplaincy

Hospice chaplaincy: The Rev Vickie Morgan is our chaplain at Mountbatten, the island's community and hospice end-of-life and palliative care provider. She offers spiritual care as well as training for other staff in how to do so. They hold regular memorial services in their chapel, including music, readings and candles.

<u>Prison chaplaincy</u>: The chaplaincy team at HM Prison Isle of Wight is led by the Rev Judith Swaine. It offers regular Sunday services, pastoral care, Bible studies and help with bereavement issues. Every Sunday there is a Eucharistic service in both chapels on the Parkhurst and Albany site. Around 30 inmates attend each. <u>Other chaplains</u>: There are a variety of other chaplains across our diocese.
